Dear Laurel Families,

Our first weeks of school have been outstanding and it has been heartwarming to see the joy and love from staff, students and families every day! Thank you SO much for your positive support, encouragement, and appreciation. It's been a great start to the school year and on behalf of all Laurel staff, THANK YOU for all you're doing. I, personally, have deeply appreciated your kind, heartfelt words about my plans to retire at the end of the school year. As I've told many of you, I plan to cherish every moment this school year and take in all the great things I love about being your school principal!



We really appreciate your help with the challenges of increased traffic during drop off and pick up. If you want to avoid the 5 to 10-minute wait in the car line, we recommend that you park along Elizabeth St., Laurel St., or another nearby street and walk onto school grounds to pick up your child. If you choose to drive through the car line, please follow the traffic pattern, show grace and patience to others, and drive slowly and carefully. Do not access the circle drive in front of the school between 7:20 – 7:50am and 2:00 – 2:30pm.

Help us ensure we maintain a safe environment:

- Avoid driving into and parking in the circle drive in front of the school **when buses are present.**
- Always dismount and walk your bike/scooter on the school grounds sidewalks.
- We are a dog friendly school. All dogs must always be on leash and under the supervision of a responsible adult.

Please regularly check your email for communications from your child's teacher, Laurel staff, and PSD. We appreciate when you read our emails to be informed about school and community events, learning opportunities, and PSD updates.

Prior to sending treats for your child's birthday treats please check with your child's teacher. Many homeroom teachers do not allow birthday treats and have alternative celebration ideas for you. We have severe allergies to nuts and bananas in our building, so we need to ensure we keep our staff and students safe and healthy.

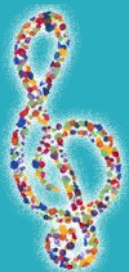

A Message from the Assistant Principal...

Dear Laurel Families,

What an amazing first couple of weeks!

We have made new friends, learned new lessons, and are having fun being back at school!

As a reminder, beginning of the year assessment have begun taking place and will continue into September. If you have any questions about any of these assessments, or why we use them, please feel free to reach out to me directly. Here is a quick guide:



- READ Act Benchmark – This assessment is conducted 1:1 and measures students’ reading performance, broken down into multiple subset areas such as first sound fluency, phonemic awareness, and accuracy. All students in K-3rd grade take this assessment, as well as any 4th-5th grade student who has a READ plan in place.
- STAR / STAR Early Literacy – This assessment is a schoolwide tool used to measure growth in both reading and math. All students K-5th grade take this assessment.
- MAP – This assessment is a districtwide tool used to measure both reading and math growth and performance. At the elementary level, it is taken by 2nd-5th grade students.

Our Lynx in the Spotlight for the month of September are *drum roll, please* AJ Charles and Aiden Siwik. See our Lynx in the Spotlight feature to learn more about why these friends are paw-some.

In addition to ROAR, Laurel students have begun starting each day in the classroom with a community circle. During this time we are able to bring social emotional learning into daily practice as another important element of learning and growth. As the year progresses, be sure to ask your child all the ways that they know how to do a calming breath and other strategies they are building for processing and talking through their emotions, challenges, and even celebrations!

Todos los estudiantes de K-3rd grado tome esta evaluación, así como cualquier 4th -5th estudiante de grado que tiene un plan READ en su lugar.
- **STAR / STAR Early Literacy**: esta evaluación es una herramienta para toda la escuela que se utiliza para medir el crecimiento tanto en lectura como en matemáticas. Todos los estudiantes K-5th grado tome esta evaluación.
- **MAP**: esta evaluación es una herramienta en todo el distrito que se utiliza para medir el crecimiento y el rendimiento tanto en lectura como en matemáticas. En el nivel elemental, se toma por 2^{Dakota del Norte} -5th estudiantes de grado.

Los boletines futuros presentarán a nuestro Lynx en el centro de atención. Esta función reconoce las amistades especiales que tenemos aquí en Laurel y se ha convertido en una nueva y maravillosa adición a nuestro boletín. Los estudiantes que son reconocidos también tienen su característica de amistad en exhibición fuera de nuestro gimnasio para que todos la vean.

Conozca a su equipo de consejería escolar

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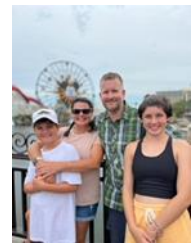

If you would like to check out library books, take Accelerated Reader tests or do IXL in the lab, come join Mrs. Reed and Mrs. Manalo each day before school starts.

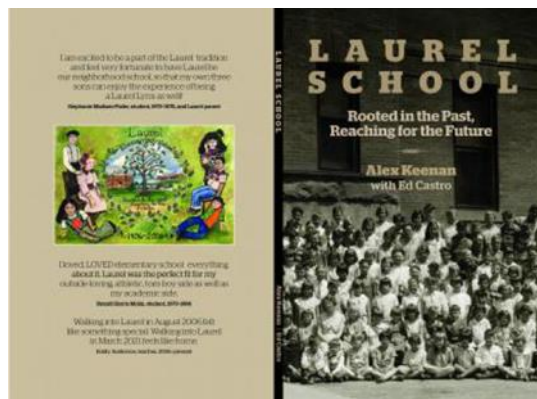


A friendly note from Secretary’s Desk:

We are celebrating Wellness Wednesdays again. Each Wednesday, we will incorporate extra movement and physical activity into our daily routines as we learn to stay active and healthy!

The Laurel School Garden

Leading the garden would entail setting up watering schedules, coordinating with teachers for planting with classes, and helping maintain the garden.

BStrongBFit

BfitBstrong is a free, after school program that focuses on healthy habits, increasing confidence, building friendships, and being fit. This running club for those who identify as girls will begin on Sept. 7th and end with a 2 mile race on Nov. 5th. Confirmation sheets will be sent home the last week of August and our first meeting will be held in Mrs. Heardon's room on Wednesday, Sept. 5th.

Laps for Laurel: Save the Date!

Laps for Laurel is scheduled for **Sept. 23rd** this year! More information will be sent out early this month. Students will be fundraising and running laps during the morning or the afternoon with their grade levels. All students will receive a water bottle and a t-shirt. Plan to come support your student(s) on this day and help raise money for Laurel!

3, 2, 1!

3 Ways to stay healthy:

- **Spend at least 20 minutes a day outside:** play a game, toss a ball, ride bikes, or take a walk while we have these beautiful sunny days. Being in the sunshine improves mood, helps your child get Vitamin D, and even improves their sleep!
- **Stay hydrated!** Please send your student to school each day with a water bottle. High temperatures mean we sweat more, so we need more water! Children who are 4-8 years old should be drinking 5 cups of water a day and 9 - 13 year olds should be drinking 7 to 8 cups.
- **Plan healthy snacks for the week.** Teach your child about balanced snacks. Instead of just eating an apple or carrot sticks, be sure to include some good fats and proteins too! A balanced snack has carbs (a great source of carbs is a fruit or veggie!), protein, and healthy fats. For example: apples and peanut butter, or a ham and cheese roll-up with some carrot sticks.

2 Ways to Be Mindful:

Students have been learning mindful habits in PE!

- **5,4,3,2,1:** In a heated moment, meltdown, or high emotional state, help your child get calm and switch to their thinking brain by asking them to name 5 things they see, 4 things they can touch, 3 things they hear, 2 things they can smell, and 1 feeling they are experiencing. Once calm, talk about how to deal with that feeling.
- **Square Breaths:** Trace a large square or rectangle in the air and breathe in for 4 on one side, hold for 4 on the top, out for 4 on the other side, hold for 4 on the bottom. Repeat 2-3 times.



1 Healthy Recipe: Zucchini Chicken Pesto Boats

INGREDIENTS

Fresh basil
Pine nuts
Garlic
Olive oil
Parmesan
Cooked chicken breast
Zucchini
salt and pepper
Cherry tomatoes
Mozzarella



INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Prepare. Preheat the oven to 375°. Arrange the zucchini halves in a 9x13 baking dish. Coat the zucchini with about 1-2 teaspoons of olive oil, then season with about ½ teaspoon of salt and ¼ teaspoon pepper. Set the dish aside.

THE STEP 2: MAKE THE PESTO: In a food processor or blender, process basil, pine nuts, garlic, and parmesan for 45 seconds. With the processor still running, slowly pour in the olive oil and continue to run the processor until the sauce is thoroughly mixed (around 2 minutes)

STEP 3: FILL THE ZUCCHINI: In a medium mixing bowl, add the sauce and chicken. Toss to coat the chicken in the sauce and then evenly distribute the chicken in the zucchini boats. Next, add the cherry tomatoes and top with cheese.

STEP 4: BAKE AND SERVE: Bake the zucchini boats for 20-25 minutes or until the zucchini are just tender. Serve warm.

Hello Parents!

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year at Laurel Elementary! The PTO would like to share some ways each family can help Laurel in funding incredible programs, activities, and educational support. We provide grants to make a difference in our children’s education.
