Create a bucket list for summer with your family: What do you want to spend time doing together this summer? Where do you want to visit or play? Who would you like to see or get together with? 2 Ways to Be Mindful:

- **Create a summer schedule**
Kids thrive on consistency and knowing what is coming next. The transition to summer after school is out can be challenging (sibling rivalry, arguing, throwing tantrums) because kids have to find their new normal. Deciding what the new morning routine is (even if it’s super simple), how you will spend your days, and sticking to normal bedtime routines will help make this transition smoother. Set up a schedule on a whiteboard or fill in the calendar together for events, camps, or outings you are planning over the summer.
- **Family Meeting: Give One, Get One**
Decide one night of the week to meet as a family, perhaps right before bed, at dinner time, or even first thing in the morning. Ask each family member to go around and share one thing they appreciate about each other and one thing they need from each other for the following week.
